- (B) Council note that the Grants and Sponsorship Guidelines, including any recommended changes, will be reported to Council for adoption following the exhibition period; and

- (C) authority be delegated to the Chief Executive Officer to make minor editorial amendments for clarity or correction of drafting errors prior to the exhibition of the draft Grants and Sponsorship Guidelines.

Purpose

To provide an Alternative Recommendation that makes requested amendments to the proposed Grants and Sponsorship Guidelines. To provide additional information on, the proposed Major Grants category and clarification of grant eligibility.

Background

A major grants category has been proposed in the draft grants and sponsorship guidelines for 2025/26. This category establishes an amalgamated set of guidelines to support organisations that have a significant impact on the City's strategic pillars and to organisations who have had a history of ongoing funding.

The major grants category provides a clear set of assessment criteria and reporting requirements for organisations that deliver significant recurring major festivals, events, programs or capital works. Applicants would need to have a proven track record, multiple sources of income, a recognised brand, support increased visitation, economic activity and/or investment in Sydney. The applicants would be required to continue to submit applications for funding before the end of their funding agreements and to report on the impact of their funding annually.

New applicants to this category can speak to City staff before applying to this category and if submitting an application it will be assessed against the published criteria. If funding is recommended the budget would need to come from within the existing funding budget. All recommendations for major grants funding, new and returning, would continue to go to Council for approval.

If the guidelines are approved, the following organisations would be moved from their current funding categories to this category with their current allocation:

Clarification on not-for-profit/for-profit grants eligibility.
