Structure and Operation of Local Pedestrian, Cycling, Traffic Calming and Transport Forum

The views expressed in this document are those of the Forum members, not necessarily the views of the City of Sydney Council.

The Local Pedestrian, Cycling, Traffic Calming and Transport Forum not a Forum of the City of Sydney Council, but a Forum of the Transport for NSW.

Council has been delegated certain powers from the Transport for NSW with regards to traffic matters on local roads. A condition of this delegation is that Council must take into account the advice of the Local Pedestrian, Cycling, Traffic Calming and Transport Forum.

The Local Pedestrian, Cycling, Traffic Calming and Transport Forum has no decision- making powers. It is primarily a technical review body which is required to advise Council on traffic related matters.

All proposals recommended by the Local Pedestrian, Cycling, Traffic Calming and Transport Forum must still be formally approved by either the elected Council or authorised Council staff (depending on the nature of the proposal).

There are four formal members of the Local Pedestrian, Cycling, Traffic Calming and Transport Forum - the City of Sydney, the Transport for NSW, the NSW Police and the local State Members of Parliament or their nominee. There are also informal advisors who may attend.

On 10 October 2024, Council appointed Councillor Adam Worling as Chairperson and Councillor Jess Miller as Alternate Chairperson of the Local Pedestrian, Cycling, Traffic Calming and Transport Forum.

Members of the public are welcome to attend and speak to an item on the Local Pedestrian, Cycling, Traffic Calming and Transport Forum agenda. Addresses to the Forum are limited to 3 minutes, but this can be extended at the discretion of the Chairperson. If a member of the public wishes to attend, it is requested that they inform the Forum Secretary in advance on ccalabro@cityofsydney.nsw.gov.au.
