The Lord Mayor opened the meeting with an Acknowledgement of Country and opening prayer.

Webcasting Statement

The Chair (the Lord Mayor), advised that in accordance with the City of Sydney Code of Meeting Practice, Council meetings are audio visually recorded and webcast live on the City of Sydney website. The Chair (the Lord Mayor) asked that courtesy and respect be observed throughout the meeting and advised those in attendance to refrain from making defamatory statements.

Item 1 Statement of Ethical Obligations and Disclosures of Interest

Statement of Ethical Obligations

In accordance with section 233A of the Local Government Act 1993, the Lord Mayor and Councillors are bound by the Oath or Affirmation of Office made at the start of the Council term to undertake their civic duties in the best interests of the people of the City of Sydney and the City of Sydney Council and to faithfully and impartially carry out the functions, powers, authorities and discretions vested in them under the Local Government Act 1993 or any other Act, to the best of their ability and judgement.

Disclosures of Interest

No Councillors disclosed any pecuniary or non-pecuniary interests in any matter on the agenda for this meeting of Council.

Item 2 Memoranda by the Chief Executive Officer**Item 2.1 City of Sydney Code of Meeting Practice 2025 - Recission****Memorandum by the Chief Executive Officer**

To Council:

On 15 December 2025 the Council resolved to adopt the 2025 City of Sydney Code of Meeting Practice, in accordance with the requirements of the Local Government (General) Amendment (Model Code of Meeting Practice) Regulation 2025 (Amendment Regulation) and the mandatory requirements of the 2025 Model Code of Meeting Practice for Local Councils in NSW (2025 Model Meeting Code).

On 26 May 2026, the Amendment Regulation which prescribed the 2025 Model Meeting Code and various other matters was disallowed by the NSW Legislative Council. This means that the 2025 Model Code is now repealed. Under the current requirements of the Local Government (General) Regulation 2021, all councils are now required to have a Code of Meeting Practice which complies with the provisions of the 2021 Model Meeting Code.

On 28 May 2026, the Office of Local Government (OLG) issued urgent advice to councils on the implications of the disallowance and the recommended actions and next steps.

The OLG advice provided that the disallowance of the Amendment Regulation means that the 2025 Model Meeting Code is no longer prescribed for the purposes of section 360 of the Local Government Act 1993 (LG Act) and the previous 2021 version of the Model Meeting Code now becomes the prescribed version.

The advice provided by the OLG was that councils should rescind the resolutions adopting their recently made Codes of Meeting Practice and that this would have the effect of reviving the previous version. Accordingly, this memorandum proposes that Council rescind the 2025 City of Sydney Code of Meeting Practice (adopted by Council on 15 December 2025) and revert to the 2024 City of Sydney Code of Meeting Practice (adopted by Council on 16 December 2024, based on the 2021 Model Code).

Practical implications/changes for June 2026

Given the recommendation to revert to the 2024 City of Sydney Code of Meeting Practice, it is proposed that commencing with the June 2026 cycle of meetings, Council and Committee meetings follow the previous operating procedure followed by the City of Sydney for many years (prior to the implementation of the 2025 Model Code).

This will also ensure that the June 2026 meetings of Council are undertaken in a way that is consistent, orderly and efficient; fair and respectful for all councillors and other meeting participants; and conducted with transparency and clearly defined rights and obligations for councillors.

Practically this will mean:

- Council briefings could take place prior to Committee and Council meetings.
- Members of the public will address Council Committees at the relevant agenda item (not at a separate public forum prior to the meeting).
- The public forum will not take place (given that members of the public will address the Committee meeting as applicable) and Council Committees will therefore commence at 2pm.

Given the removal of public forums, it is recommended that the functions of Council Committees be revised to a 2pm commencement time. It is also noted that following these changes to how members of the community can speak to Council (reverting back to the previous operating procedure), public notification and communications will be updated to reflect this.

Next steps for the NSW Government

The OLG have advised that they have been examining feedback received on the 2025 Model Meeting Code and that work on an updated code will be completed shortly. Formal advice on a new code will be shared by OLG when the drafting is complete.

It is noted that Council will be required to adopt a new code of meeting practice that incorporates the mandatory provisions of the model code after it is made by the OLG (following a public exhibition period).

Recommendation

It is resolved that:
