I just heard that Hyper Karting at Moore Park is at risk of closing and I had to reach out.

This place is a genuine gem for Sydney. Over 500,000 people have visited since it opened in 2021, it employs more than 150 people, and it runs seven days a week for families, kids, and anyone looking for something fun to do in the city. It also runs programs for NDIS participants and has helped develop real motorsport talent. That's not nothing.

I get that parking is a concern, but turning a packed, well-loved entertainment venue back into an empty car park doesn't feel like the right call — especially when a new underground lot is apparently on the way anyway.

All that's being asked for is a two-year extension. That seems very reasonable given everything Hyper Karting brings to the precinct and to Sydney as a whole.

Please reconsider. Grant the extension, work with the Hyper Karting team, and let's find a solution that works for everyone.

To the Sydney City Council Planning Committee,

I am writing to formally express my strong opposition to the proposed closure of the go-karting venue located within the Entertainment Quarter (EQ).

As a frequent visitor to the precinct, I believe the removal of this facility would be a significant loss to the community for several reasons:

- **Vitality of the Entertainment Quarter:** The precinct is specifically designated as a hub for leisure and recreation. Currently, the "entertainment" offerings at the EQ are relatively sparse, removing one of the few active, high-engagement social activities contradicts the very purpose of the area and further reduces the incentive for people to visit.
- **Minimal Environmental Impact:** Unlike traditional tracks, this venue utilises modern, quiet electric karts. They produce negligible noise pollution and zero exhaust emissions, ensuring that the operation remains a "good neighbor" to the surrounding Moore Park area.
- **Optimal Land Use:** The facility occupies a section of the carpark that is consistently under-utilised. Even during peak periods, the carpark has more than enough capacity to house both the venue and visitor vehicles. Keeping the track open utilises this space productively without negatively impacting local infrastructure or traffic flow.
- **Central Accessibility:** This is the only go-karting location in central Sydney. Forcing its closure would require residents to travel significant distances to the outer suburbs to access similar recreation, increasing cross-city traffic and removing a unique amenity from the inner-city landscape.
- **Economic & Social Value:** Closing the venue will inevitably lead to reduced visitation to the Entertainment Quarter as a whole, which will have a secondary negative impact on nearby cafes, restaurants, and retail businesses.

Sydney's nightlife and social scene have faced numerous challenges in recent years. Rather than removing established social anchors, the Council should be protecting venues that provide safe, inclusive, and active entertainment.

I urge the Council to reconsider this closure and instead support the continued operation of a business that contributes positively to the city's vibrancy.

Dear Shannon Rickersey,

I am writing to express my support in the current application RD 2023/897 A and the continued operation of Hyper Karting at the Entertainment Quarter. I'm a local resident visitor member of community from Brighton Le Sands. Hyper Karting has brought back life to the Entertainment Quarter, which it previously struggled to maintain its liveliness and culture in a booming Sydney, in terms of activities to do and entertainment. I've genuinely enjoyed my experiences at Hyper Karting over the years as a regular visitor. Sharing the experience of Hyper Karting with my friends has created great memories. It's become one of our go-to activities when we're looking to spend time outside of the city. Without Hyper Karting, EQ lacks any life, a very monotonous atmosphere that struggles to grasp the wants of the community and people from not just Sydney city itself, but surrounding suburbs too.

I myself, typically travel to this location by light rail which is why it has taken me by surprise to see the focus on parking as a primary concern. My experience aligns with what's stated in the application documents. That an abundance of visitors to the Entertainment Quarter do not rely on driving to get there. Even when I have driven, I haven't personally experienced major parking issues outside of large event days. As a regular visitor to this location, I can attest that the Entertainment Quarter car park, is fairly accessible in terms of parking, in which I do not struggle to find parking. From what I understand, the traffic assessment also found that the actual parking demand generated by Hyper Karting is relatively low (around 27 spaces), and that the broader car park still has significant capacity most of the time. That reflects what I've seen myself when visiting.

Hyper Karting plays in keeping the Entertainment Quarter alive. It is the primary source for the vivacious energy and excitement it brings to the location. It promotes higher foot traffic in off peak seasons when there are no events at surrounding venues, supports nearby businesses, and provides a space for family gatherings and social connection, especially for younger communities and groups. Losing Hyper Karting at the Entertainment Quarter wouldn't just mean losing a business. It would take away from an already diminishing Sydney entertainment life, reduce foot traffic and revenue and make the location less worth visiting. This highlights the broader contribution Hyper Karting upholds within the Entertainment Quarter and local economy and community. It is also noted within the application notes, that the venue supports roughly around 150 jobs, in a Sydney economy where the cost of living is incredibly significant, the impact this could have on the individuals who need this job for survival and living, is exasperating to think about. Keeping this business up and running, is clearly in the best interest for the public. If there are concerns, it seems far more reasonable to manage them through other conditions, such as utilising the grass fields as additional car spaces, continue encouraging the use of the fairly new established light rail, rather than allowing the venue to close altogether.

I respectfully ask that you take my email into consideration, as a valued member of the community and to please reconsider the review application status. We do not deserve to lose this business and to be stripped off the very entertainment we sought for within the Entertainment Quarter.

I am writing to formally express my objection to the proposed closure of Hyper Karting (HK), which I understand is being considered to facilitate additional car parking at the Entertainment Quarter.

I wish to clarify that I have no financial or commercial interest in Hyper Karting; I am submitting this as a concerned member of the public who values evidence-based urban planning and the preservation of Sydney's recreational diversity.

My objection is based on the following points:

- 1. Lack of Demonstrated Demand for Parking** The current Entertainment Quarter multi-level car park frequently operates below capacity. Replacing a high-utilization, active business with additional parking infrastructure—without transparent, independent data proving a deficit—is an inefficient use of land. It risks creating a "dead zone" of underutilized asphalt in place of a vibrant commercial hub.
- 2. Economic and Employment Impact** Hyper Karting is a significant employer, providing jobs for approximately 150 individuals. In the current economic climate, the removal of a viable employer for the sake of passive infrastructure is counter-intuitive. Furthermore, HK acts as a "destination tenant," driving foot traffic to neighboring hospitality and retail businesses within the EQ precinct.
- 3. Loss of Social Infrastructure** HK provides a unique social utility that cannot be easily replicated or relocated. It serves as a vital venue for corporate engagement, youth recreation, and tourism. Removing this venue effectively removes these social opportunities from the inner-city landscape, diminishing the EQ's appeal as a premier entertainment destination.
- 4. Alignment with Modern Planning Principles** Modern urban planning for Sydney emphasizes "Place Making" and reducing reliance on private vehicle infrastructure. Prioritizing more car parking over active recreation contradicts the Council's broader goals of creating a walkable, lively, and sustainable city.

Requested Actions: I respectfully urge the Council to:

- **Require an Independent Parking Utilization Study** to verify if the existing supply is truly insufficient before approving any change of use.
- **Examine Multi-use Alternatives** that allow for the retention of Hyper Karting alongside any necessary infrastructure upgrades.
- **Provide a Public Benefit Test** to explain how additional parking provides greater value to the community than an active, job-creating recreation business.

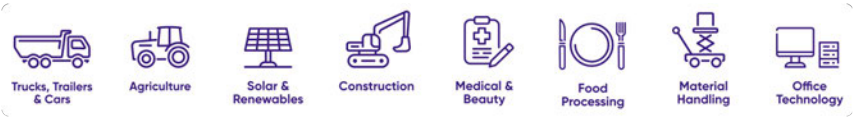

Facilities like this are increasingly rare in urban environments, and their preservation should be prioritised.

From an economic standpoint, Hyper Karting supports local employment and drives foot traffic to surrounding businesses within Moore Park. Its presence enhances the attractiveness of the precinct as a destination, rather than simply a transient space for parking.

Replacing such a dynamic and community-focused venue with a car park would represent a step backwards in terms of urban planning and community value. While parking infrastructure is important, it should not come at the expense of established businesses that actively contribute to the vibrancy, wellbeing, and identity of the area.

I strongly encourage the Council to consider the broader, long-term benefits of retaining Hyper Karting and to explore alternative solutions that support both accessibility and community engagement without displacing this valued business.

I write to formally request that you reconsider the current planning proposal and approve the extension of the permit permitting Hyperkarting to continue its operations. The closure of this facility would constitute a significant detriment to the local community, the economy, and the broader Moore Park precinct.

I respectfully ask that the following matters be given due consideration prior to any final determination:

Traffic and Parking Considerations

The suggestion that Hyperkarting contributes to ongoing issues of patrons parking on surrounding grassed areas is no longer reflective of the present circumstances. Should parking capacity remain a concern, it would be more appropriate to examine the limitations of the SCG parking facilities, which are highly restricted and not readily accessible to the general public.

More broadly, the traffic and parking challenges within the precinct are the result of systemic infrastructure and traffic management shortcomings, rather than the operations of Hyperkarting. As anyone attempting to leave the Allianz Stadium or SCG after major events will have observed, the Entertainment Quarter car park experiences severe congestion due to inefficient exit traffic sequencing, which permits only a minimal number of vehicles to depart at any given time. This regularly results in significant delays for patrons. The closure of Hyperkarting would not address, nor resolve, these underlying deficiencies.

Economic Impact and Employment

The refusal of the permit extension would result in the immediate loss of approximately 150 positions, mostly filled by young adults. Such an outcome would have a material and adverse impact on the local economy and on the individuals whose livelihoods depend on this employment. It is imperative that decisions of this nature give due weight to their broader economic consequences.

Impact on the Entertainment Quarter Precinct

The Entertainment Quarter is presently facing notable challenges in sustaining consistent visitor engagement and commercial activity. Hyperkarting serves as a key attraction within the precinct, generating regular foot traffic and supporting surrounding businesses. Its closure would not only remove a successful and well-utilised facility, but would also have a consequential negative effect on neighbouring enterprises that rely on this patronage.

In light of the above, I respectfully urge you to support the continuation of Hyperkarting's operations by approving the requested permit extension. Such a decision would safeguard employment, support the local economy, and contribute positively to the ongoing viability of the Moore Park precinct.

I am writing to lodge a formal submission in relation to **RD/2023/897/A** concerning the ongoing operation of **Hyper Karting Sydney** on Level 5 of the Entertainment Quarter car park at **116 Lang Road, Moore Park**.

I wish to express my strong opposition to the City of Sydney's decision to refuse the application to maintain the existing Level 5 karting centre.

Hyper Karting has become a major and genuinely successful attraction within the Entertainment Quarter since commencing operations. It has transformed what was previously underutilised rooftop parking space into a year-round destination that attracts families, young people, corporate groups, tourists, and the broader Sydney community. Its contribution to the vibrancy, economic activity and public life of Moore Park is significant and measurable.

Public reporting indicates the refusal is primarily based on the loss of approximately 298 parking spaces and the Council's intention to return the area to vehicle parking to offset the staged removal of grass parking in Moore Park. I respectfully submit that this reasoning does not adequately reflect current transport behaviour, parking utilisation, or the City of Sydney's own strategic objectives.

In particular,

- The Entertainment Quarter already benefits from strong public transport access, including the Moore Park light rail, bus services and pedestrian connectivity to major venues.
- Parking demand at the Entertainment Quarter is highly event-driven, with the rooftop level historically underutilised outside major stadium events.
- Significant new parking supply is being delivered nearby, including large underground parking facilities, which will mitigate future reductions in surface and grass parking.
- The City of Sydney has consistently articulated a vision of reducing car dependency, encouraging activation, and prioritising people-focused uses over private vehicle storage.

Removing a proven, high-performing entertainment venue in order to reinstate parking appears inconsistent with these objectives.

Beyond planning theory, the real-world impacts of this decision are substantial. Hyper Karting employs more than 150 people (as reported in March 2026 media coverage), many of them young workers gaining their first employment experience. The venue supports local hospitality and retail businesses and contributes to Moore Park functioning as an active destination outside of major event days. Its closure would remove a unique, inclusive and weather-independent activity with no clear public benefit gained in return.

Importantly, Hyper Karting was established with Council approval and has operated without material amenity impacts on surrounding land uses. The facility is electric, enclosed, and subject to operational controls that have demonstrably worked. The proposal does not seek to expand the footprint or intensify impacts beyond what the community has already embraced.

I respectfully request that the City of Sydney reconsider its position, or at minimum give further weight to

- the demonstrated social and economic benefits,

- the low-impact adaptive reuse of existing infrastructure,
- the availability of alternative parking supply,
- and the long-term value of maintaining Moore Park as an active, diverse and people-focused precinct.

I am writing to strongly urge the City of Sydney Council to reconsider the decision to reclaim the top level of the Entertainment Quarter (EQ) car park (currently the site of Hyperkarting) for the use of private vehicle parking. As a lifelong City of Sydney resident and landscape architect, I am deeply invested in the City's vision for a pedestrian-prioritised, 30-minute city. However, removing a thriving, community-focused business to create dormant car parking directly contradicts this progressive ethos.

The Entertainment Quarter is currently struggling to maintain its status as a vibrant cultural hub. In this dying public realm, Hyperkarting stands out as one of the few genuinely dynamic attractions keeping the precinct alive. It acts as a vital social anchor, drawing families, friends, and tourists, which in turn injects much-needed foot traffic and economic stimulus into the surrounding local businesses.

Replacing this activated space with parking is fundamentally flawed from both an urban design and a logistical standpoint:

- **Dormant Infrastructure:** Outside of major sporting events, the top levels of the EQ car park sit vacant. Reclaiming this space means sacrificing a 7-day-a-week economic and social driver for concrete that will sit empty 99% of the time.
- **Traffic Chaos:** Funnelling thousands of game-day attendees into this car park will inevitably result in severe localised congestion. With an entrance limited to three lanes and an exit bottlenecked to just two, this decision guarantees traffic gridlock rather than efficient movement. It also will cause further traffic congestion on the already crowded Cleveland St during peak periods.
- **Undermining Public Transport Investment:** The NSW Government has invested \$3.1 billion into the CBD and South East Light Rail to safely and efficiently move large groups of people directly into the stadium precinct. Reintroducing high-capacity parking directly competes with this infrastructure, incentivising private vehicle use and deterring people from utilising the mass transit network built explicitly for this purpose.
- **Reversing Pedestrian Connectivity:** The City of Sydney recently directed a \$220 million contribution toward the transformation of the light rail corridor and the Devonshire Street upgrades. This was a significant step toward linking Central Station and the stadium precinct with a strong, pedestrian-friendly active transport corridor. Prioritising car parking takes a massive step backwards, compromising the "30-minute city" model these funds were meant to achieve.

The City of Sydney has consistently championed the reallocation of space away from cars to create a more livable, activated, and sustainable environment. Sacrificing a successful, high-amenity destination like Hyperkarting to warehouse empty vehicles flies in the face of the Sustainable Sydney 2030–2050 vision.

I respectfully ask that the City of Sydney and relevant stakeholders reconsider this decision, and choose to support the businesses and the urban design principles that actually bring our public spaces to life.

Dear City of Sydney Planning Department,

I am writing to express my concern regarding the City's decision not to grant an extension of the lease for Hyper Karting at the Moore Park car park. I believe this outcome risks losing a unique and valuable recreational asset that contributes meaningfully to Sydney's culture and vibrancy.

From a broader planning perspective, it seems inconsistent that car parking requirements are often reduced or removed in new residential developments under the vision of a public transport-focused city, while at the same time existing parking and car-based recreational uses are being displaced. This approach can place increased pressure on surrounding street and commercial parking, and does not fully reflect the ongoing importance of personal transport within a growing city.

While public transport investment is critical, the need for well-planned, purpose-built parking infrastructure remains. There is an opportunity to better integrate parking within new developments in a way that supports both residents and the wider public, rather than shifting the burden onto existing facilities or removing established uses.

In this context, I suggest the City consider a more structured mechanism to secure public parking supply through the development process. For example, where a developer seeks approval for reduced or nil onsite parking, the City could require the delivery of basement parking in lieu of those spaces, or facilitate it through infrastructure contributions as part of a Voluntary Planning Agreement (VPA). These basement levels could then be dedicated for public use, with the City retaining ownership and operation, or leasing the asset similar to how other VPA works such as internal roads and public infrastructure are delivered and managed. This would provide a long-term, scalable solution to parking demand while

aligning with broader planning objectives.

Hyper Karting, in particular, provides a strong drawcard for the Moore Park precinct. It is widely used for social and team-building activities I, along with friends and colleagues, regularly attend and its removal would represent a significant loss to the area for what appears to be a relatively modest gain in parking capacity.

I also note that parts of the existing structure, such as the open-air upper level, appear underutilised. There may be opportunities to activate this space potentially through complementary uses such as hospitality or entertainment offerings to further enhance the precinct's appeal and economic activity.

I appreciate that balancing competing planning priorities is complex. However, I encourage the City to reconsider this decision or explore alternative solutions that retain Hyper Karting while addressing parking and congestion challenges in a more strategic, long-term manner.

Hyper Karting is a huge drawcard for us and one of the main reasons we choose to spend our time and money at the EQ. It's a unique, well-run business that creates a genuine sense of activity on a rooftop that would otherwise be dead space. It seems counter-intuitive for the Council to prioritise more car parking over a business that is clearly contributing to the "vibrant, 24-hour city" ethos that the City of Sydney has been championing lately.
