I am writing to express my strong support for the renewal of the Development Approval (DA) for Hyper Karting at Moore Park.

Hyper Karting has become a unique and valuable attraction within the Moore Park precinct, contributing significantly to the vibrancy and activation of the area. Its presence offers an engaging, family-friendly recreational option that complements the broader mix of entertainment, sporting, and hospitality venues nearby.

The venue helps draw a diverse range of visitors, including families, young adults, corporate groups, and tourists. This increased foot traffic supports surrounding businesses and contributes to a more dynamic and economically active precinct. In particular, Hyper Karting enhances the appeal of Moore Park as a destination beyond major events, encouraging consistent visitation throughout the week.

It is my understanding that the proposed reason for declining the renewal is to convert the space into additional car parking. However, this appears to be a poor trade-off, particularly given that existing parking capacity in the area is often underutilised outside of major event days. Replacing a vibrant, experience-driven attraction with largely empty parking spaces would detract from the precinct's appeal and undermine efforts to create a lively, people-focused destination.

Additionally, the facility promotes social interaction, safe recreational activity, and community engagement. It provides an accessible and exciting experience that is not widely available elsewhere in Sydney, helping to distinguish Moore Park as a leading entertainment hub.

From an urban planning perspective, retaining attractions like Hyper Karting aligns with broader goals of activating public spaces, encouraging local tourism, and fostering a lively and inclusive environment. Removing such a facility would diminish the diversity of experiences available in the area and reduce its overall appeal.

For these reasons, I strongly support the renewal of Hyper Karting's DA and encourage the

relevant authorities to recognise its positive contribution to the precinct's vibrancy, economy, and community life, rather than replacing it with infrastructure that does not meaningfully enhance the precinct.

Dear City of Sydney Council,

I am writing to share my concerns about the proposed closure of the HyperKarting facility in the entertainment precinct.

This proposal would have a serious impact on both workers and the wider community. Around 150 employees could lose their jobs, which is a significant consequence for a decision that does not appear to deliver clear benefits.

The reasoning behind replacing the venue with additional parking is also questionable. Even during major events, such as football matches, there seem to be ample parking spaces available. With a new car park already under construction nearby, increasing parking capacity further feels unnecessary.

Additionally, this move seems inconsistent with the broader goal of encouraging sustainable transport. Public transport options, such as the light rail, already make the precinct easily accessible without relying on cars. Expanding parking sends the opposite message at a time when reducing car dependency should be a priority.

HyperKarting itself provides something genuinely valuable to the community. It offers a safe, social, and engaging environment, particularly for younger people. The atmosphere is welcoming, with friendly and supportive staff who help create a positive experience for everyone.

It is also a unique venue that operates year-round, regardless of weather conditions. The use of electric karts is another major benefit, reducing environmental impact by avoiding fuel emissions and supporting a cleaner, more sustainable activity.

Losing a place like this would take away an important recreational and social space in a city where many similar venues have already disappeared. It would be disappointing to see such a positive community asset replaced by infrastructure that may not even be needed.

I respectfully ask the Council to reconsider this proposal and to recognise the value that HyperKarting brings to Sydney.

The joy that Hyperkarting brings to my grandsons is incredible. This facility is unique in the Eastern Suburbs in terms of the experiences offered as well as the accessibility.

I know of many families in the East (and from adjacent suburbs) who access this facility. To lose it would remove a major source of family entertainment in the Eastern Suburbs.

It is fair to say that the Entertainment Quarter has for many years suffered a decline in visitors with the resultant effect on business there. To remove a commercially viable operation such as Hyperkarting would be counter intuitive.

To convert the Hyperkart area back to parking spaces which would quite clearly remain empty on most days of any year is quite confusing to me. Especially so when additional car parking is being constructed at the football stadium.

In summary, my objections to reverting the space to car spaces;

As a visitor who values the vibrancy and community facilities in Moore Park, I believe this decision will have significant negative impacts on the area.

I urge you to support the extension based on the following grounds:

1. **Retention of Valuable Community and Economic Activity:** Hyper Karting is not merely a commercial operation; it is a major attraction that has engaged over 500,000 visitors since 2021, fostering a family-friendly atmosphere at the EQ. Closing it would remove one of the most popular attractions in the precinct, directly undermining the goal of creating a thriving entertainment destination. I am writing to formally object to the proposed closure of the top level car park at 116 Lang Road, Moore Park, currently occupied by Hyper Karting, under submission RD/2023/897/A.

The current 'decision' that appears to be swinging towards removing Hyper Karting's rights up operate on Level 5 of the Entertainment Quarter's car park is disgraceful! Please clarify what good reasons are there to remove over 150 jobs?!? To save a couple hundred parking spots when there's a new 1000+ space stadium car park being constructed within the next year or so? Where is the logic for this???

Moore Park, Sydney, Australia... it doesn't matter where we are in the country. We aren't the United States with their ridiculously sized parking lots circling around stadiums. Our sporting and event culture has always encouraged as much of the general public as possible to utilise the multiple public transport options we have, and we should continue to do so! The traffic situation around Entertainment Quarter / Moore Park (Lang Road) is already severe on big event nights and you want to exacerbate that? Right now, it often takes up to an hour if not longer to exit the car park, get through Lang Road and onto Anzac Parade. Lang Road is a narrow two lane road and there are no plans to increase the lanes for more capacity (mainly because it's not physically possible without cutting down dozens of trees) . So please explain what's with the need to open up more car spaces?

As you have probably received photographic evidence from the team at Hyper Karting which apparently has been ignored rather conveniently, the car park at EQ is often barely half full during the day time. And on nights where there's concerts at Hordern Pavilion, games at the SCG and Allianz Stadium, there's usually still many parking spaces still available. As a customer of Hyper Karting who frequents the venue consistently at night once a week, if not multiple times, I can also confirm their evidence.

The Entertainment Quarter is usually void of life outside of the occasional concerts, sporting and seasonal events. Hyper Karting is literally the main reason EQ is still relevant in these periods, having attracted over several hundred thousand visitors in the last few years. Do better and pay attention to what's really the source of energy and entertainment to the precinct!

I am writing to strongly oppose the proposed closure of the go-kart track at Moore Park to make way for additional car parking.

The go-kart track is a well-used, accessible and unique recreational facility that provides ongoing value to the community. It is consistently busy throughout the week and is a rare example of an affordable, active entertainment option in the eastern suburbs. In contrast, the proposed replacement—additional car parking—would only reach capacity during major events and would otherwise remain underutilised for much of the year.

Moore Park should be prioritised as a recreational and sporting precinct, not converted further into car-dominated infrastructure. The go-kart track encourages active recreation, supports families, young people, and groups, and contributes to the vibrancy and liveability of the area.

Importantly, the facility has become a recognised attraction that has helped put the eastern suburbs on the map as a destination for accessible urban recreation. Removing it would be a loss of a valued community asset that cannot be easily replaced elsewhere.
