

Item 10.**Street Event - Temporary Road Closures - Spring Cycle 2026****TRIM Container No.: 2026/351782****Recommendations**

It is recommended that the Forum review the temporary road closures for the Spring Cycle 2026 on Sunday, 11 October 2026 from 4am to 11.30am subject to the following conditions:

- (A) The Applicant must comply with the temporary road closure conditions as stipulated in Schedule A of this agenda.
- (B) The Applicant must contact the Sydney City PAC to discuss deployment of user pay police for the event.
- (C) The Applicant must contact the City's Venue Management Unit to discuss the event.
- (D) The Applicant is to obtain a Road Occupancy Licence from the Transport Management Centre prior to commencement of works.
- (E) The Applicant must provide a telephone number of the supervisor responsible for the proposed event and include contact details in the notification letters to be distributed to affected stakeholders.
- (F) The Applicant must contact relevant Bus Operators and arrange and pay for the rerouting of bus services around the closures, the temporary relocation of bus stops and any additional staff required.
- (G) The Applicant must contact all shared e-bike operators within the City of Sydney Local Government Area to discuss the management of shared e-bikes within and around the event footprint. This includes, but is not limited to, the identification of any requirements for temporary geofencing, restricted parking/drop-off zones, or the relocation of bikes to ensure they do not obstruct road closures, event operations, or present safety concerns.

Bicycle NSW has applied for the temporary road closures of streets in the City of Sydney for the Spring Cycle 2026 on Sunday, 11 October 2026 from 4am to 11.30am.

Comments

The Spring Cycle 2026 is a recurring event that requires the temporary closure of the following City streets and traffic detours around the event route on Sunday 11 October 2026.

Road Closures

0400 to 1100 - Sydney CBD / The Rocks / Millers Point

- *Cahill Expressway between Bradfield Highway and Conservatorium Road (State Road)*
- Conservatorium Road between Macquarie Street and Cahill Expressway on/off ramps
- Grosvenor Street between Lang Street and York Street (westbound)
- Argyle Place between Kent Street and Bettington Street (westbound) *1
- Argyle Street between Lower Fort Street and Kent Street (westbound)
- Dalgety Road between Bettington Street and Towns Place (westbound)
- Hickson Road between Towns Place and Napoleon Street (southbound) *2
- Napoleon Street between Kent Street and Sussex Street (westbound) *3
- Merriman Street from Bettington Street *1
- Rodens Lane from Bettington Street *1
- Sussex Street between Napoleon Street and King Street (southbound) *4

- Towns Place between Dalgety Road and Hickson Road (eastbound)
- Upper Fort Street between Watson Road and Sydney Observatory *5
- Watson Road between Upper Fort Street and Argyle Street *5

Notes

1. Managed access to Bettington Street, Merriman Street and Rodens Lane via Dalgety Road southbound. No access to Argyle Place from High Street.
2. Local access to Hickson Road south of Towns Place managed by NSW Police.
3. Managed local access to Napoleon Street.
4. Cross Sussex Street via Erskine Street. Managed access to Slip Street via Erskine Street.
5. Managed local access to Observatory Hill under traffic control at Argyle Street and Watson Road.

0400 to 1130 - Sydney CBD / Haymarket / Pyrmont

- *Darling Drive between Ultimo Road and Pier Street offramp (northbound) (PMNSW Road)*
- *Western Distributor between Pyrmont Street and Sussex Street (State Road)*
- Pyrmont Street between Pyrmont Bridge Road & Western Distributor
- Pyrmont Bridge Road between Harris Street & Murray Street

0700 to 1130 - Sydney CBD / Haymarket / Pyrmont

- *Darling Drive between Harbourside and Murray Street (northbound) *1 (PMNSW Road)*
- Harris Street north of Bowman Street *2

Notes

1. Managed access to Bettington Street, Merriman Street and Rodens Lane via Dalgety Road southbound. No access to Argyle Place from High Street.
2. Local access to Hickson Road south of Towns Place managed by NSW Police.

0630 to 1100 - Ultimo

- Kelly Street between Mountain Street and Bay Street Eastbound
- Mountain Lane between West End Lane and Kelly Street

There are currently no other approved temporary road closures in the area proposed to take place on the same day.
