

Item 16.**Parking - No Stopping - Flora Street, Erskineville**

Recommendations

It is recommended that the Committee review the allocation of parking on the eastern side of Flora Street, Erskineville between the points 0 metres and 10 metres (two car spaces) north of Coulston Street as "No Stopping".

Advice

Background

A resident of Flora Street, Erskineville has requested consideration of "No Stopping" in Flora Street, Erskineville to improve sight lines, accommodate waste vehicles and safety of traffic flow.

Comments

The kerb space on the eastern side of Flora Street, north of Coulson Street, where the changes are proposed, is currently unrestricted for parking.

Under the NSW Road Rules 2014, a driver must not stop on a road within 10 metres from an intersection without traffic lights. Parking at intersections can obstruct driver vision and cause unsafe conditions especially for pedestrians crossing the road.

Signs are not required to enforce this rule and it is the responsibility of drivers to be aware of all current traffic and parking laws. The City will, however, install signage and linemarking to clarify the "No Stopping" restriction in response to safety concerns received about this location.

Consultation

The City notified local residents and businesses in the area. There were 117 letters sent out with no responses supporting or opposing the proposal.

Financial

Funds are available in the current budget.
