

Item 11.**Parking - 4P Mobility Parking - Vine Street, Redfern**

Recommendations

It is recommended that the Committee review the following reallocation of parking:

- On the northern side of Vine Street, Redfern between the points 4 metres and 11.8 metres east of Evans Lane as "4P Mobility Parking 8am-10pm".
- On the southern side of Vine Street, Redfern between the points 9.5 metres and 17.3 metres west of Hugo Street as "Unrestricted" parking.

Background

The City's Inclusion (Disability) Action Plan 2021-2025 (IDAP) includes a series of actions designed to actively address barriers faced by people with disability.

One of the actions identified in the IDAP is to "continue to explore and implement strategies to increase access to on-street and off-street accessible parking and drop off points in the City of Sydney area".

Previously the proposal of these changes on the southern side of Vine Street, Redfern, were endorsed and installed in line with the actions recommended in the IDAP, "4P Mobility Parking 8am-10pm". However, due to constructability issues with the tram ramp, the City is proposing to relocate the space on the northern side of Vine Street.

Comments

The kerb space where the changes are proposed is currently signposted as "2P 8.30am-10.30pm Permit Holders Excepted Area 32". The proposed parking changes would limit any vehicle with a NSW Mobility Parking Scheme permit to four hours of parking between 8am-10pm seven days a week where the signs are installed.

The southern side of Vine Street, where it is currently signposted as "4P Mobility Parking 8am-10pm", will revert to unrestricted parking.

Consultation

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 280 letters sent out with no responses supporting or opposing the proposal.

Financial

Funds are available in the current budget.
